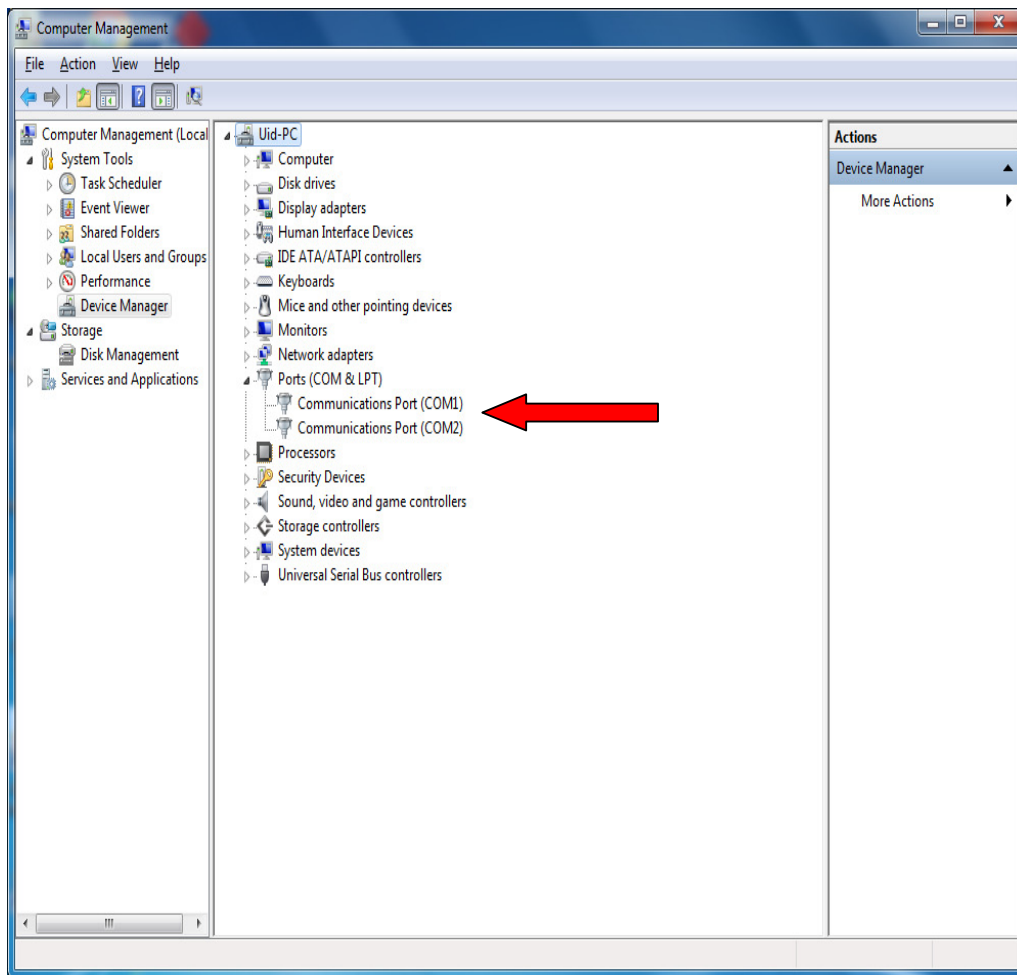


IG-CBI TRANSLINE GPS INSTALLATION GUIDE

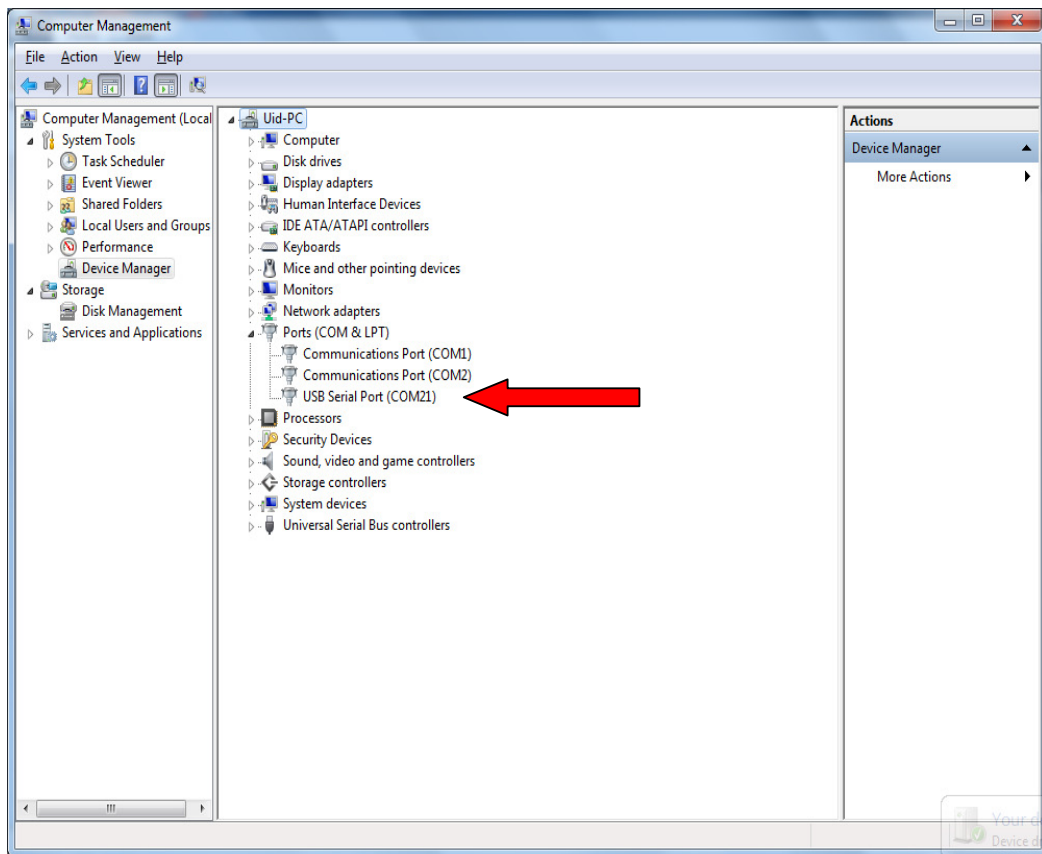


Step 1: This Gps is plug N Play but before plug in to your system you can check your system device manager Like this in ports column this show only communication port



Step 2 : After Connected gps on USB port, wait for 2 minutes to complete the setup automatically then go to device manager again for confirming that gps is connected or not

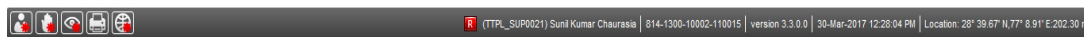
GPS showing in device manager in ports column like this:



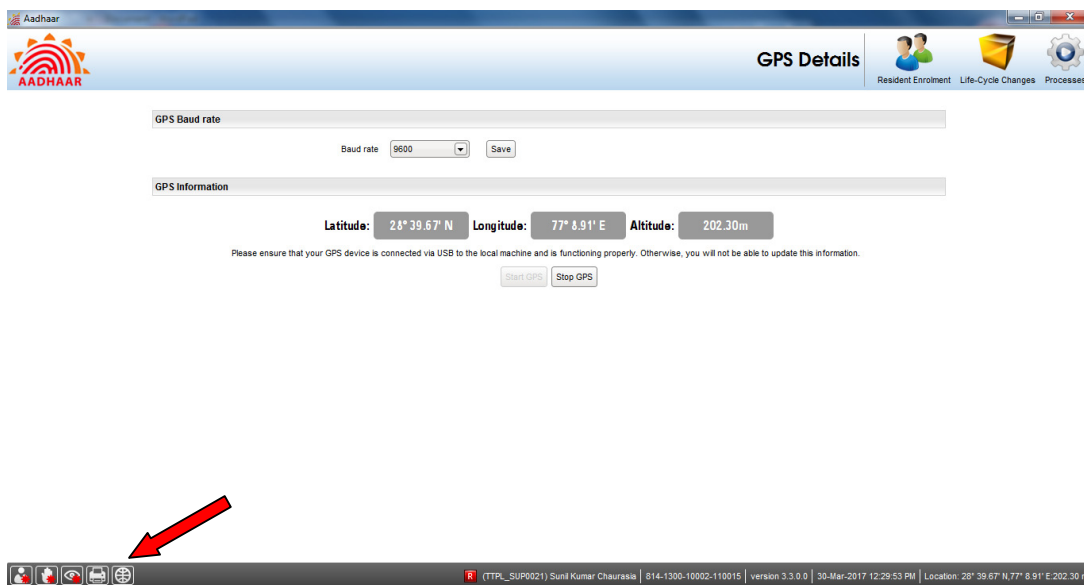
Step 3 : Then open UIDAI ECMP application & go to GPS details in Process menu tab on right side.

Step 4 : After entering the gps details you will see this kind of window, Then save the Baud rate to 9600 then click on start gps button and wait for 2 minutes to get ready with co-ordinates(Latitude & Longitude)



When GPS has connected with UIDAI app, red spot disappear automatically in bottom of the screen.



After few seconds gps device is blinking then coordinates are showing on UIDAI app like this.
